End of Key Stage 1 Expectations

By the end of Year 2 most pupils should be able to do work which requires them to:

- Visit existing places online, but to follow certain rules to remain safe.
- Go to a responsible adult if they feel in danger.
- Be able to understand the importance of asking for help from an adult when on the internet.
- Understand the benefits of ICT and be able to use it responsibly.
- Understand not to give out personal information.
- Learn to be responsible when using the internet.
- Know how to use email safely.
- Understand age limits for the use of social networks (over 13 years Facebook and Instagram, Whatsapp 16)
- Understand and be aware of safe texting and mobile security.
- Learn not to reveal private, personal information to anyone online.
- Recognise the signs of cyberbullying and to understand it's consequences.
- Encourage the need for courtesy, tolerance and respect.
- What to do if they receive a call or text from an unknown number.
- Not to download apps, but that this should be done by an adult.
- Stay safe when using FaceTime.
