Year One Maths Homework

This homework relates to Maths work covered in class this week.

Children are revising how to order numbers (0 to 10 and 10 to 0).

This is a practical activity:

0	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9	10
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Together with your child, make a set of **number 'flashcards'** - 0 to 10.

Play some number games:

1. Mix up the cards and spread them out, face up. Get your child to make the above number line from memory. If s/he gets stuck, ask them to "count to 10" in order to work it out.
2. Make the above number line, but leave some numbers out - put these to one side, face up. Can your child find the missing numbers? If s/he gets stuck, ask them to "count to 10" again in order to work it out.
3. Choose 3 or 4 consecutive numbers (e.g. 3, 4, 5 & 6). Mix them up and ask your child to put them into the correct order.

When your child is confident with ordering numbers in ascending order, repeat the above activities - instead asking him/her to rearrange the numbers in descending order (10 to 1).
