

## Thames View Infants Guided Write Scheme of Work

### Reception, Term 3B

#### **Summary**

Developing early writing skills using previously taught and practised skills from Letters and Sounds (including some Phase 4 and 5 blends and sounds).

Children develop their writing skills through daily Letters and Sounds (phonics) lessons from the beginning of Term 1B. Daily phonics lesson continue and is supplemented by the weekly Writing sessions which take place in small groups.

Writing continues to take inspiration from literature read in class. At the end of Term 3B children write a short story based on one of their favourite books they have written about during the year. This assessment is used to supplement the EYFS profile and provide evidence of each child's writing ability for the Year 1 teachers.

#### **Key Skills**

Across the sessions the following skills are taught consistently. These skills are also consistently taught across the rest of the provision in 'freeflow' and consolidation time

- I can use a capital letter at the beginning, and a full stop at the end of my sentence
- I can write left to write across the page
- I can form most of my letters correctly
- I can write to the end of the line
- I can sound out words and use the sounds I know to spell
- I can remember how to spell 'tricky' (high frequency) words
- I can write the words I say in my sentence
- I can write on the line
- I can use connectives to join my sentences together
- I can sound out longer words
- I can use time sequence vocabulary
- I can use adjectives to describe what I am writing about and make my writing more interesting
- I can use everything I've learnt about writing when I write for different reasons
