Year Two Maths Homework

This homework relates to Maths work covered in class this week. Children are ordering 3 digit numbers (smallest to largest and largest to smallest). Encourage your child to look at each of the digits and then discuss the value of each ("Is it a 'hundred', 'ten' or 'one'?"). A good strategy is to first consider the value of the 'hundred' digit, then the 'tens' and finally the 'one'. If your child is struggling with ordering 3 digit numbers, ignore the 'hundred' digit and get them to order 2 digit numbers instead.

Look at the below numbers carefully. Order them smallest to largest and largest to smallest.

Order these numbers - smallest to largest:

809 872 826 855

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Order these numbers - largest to smallest:

346 865 106 839

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Order these numbers - smallest to largest:

742 746 744 747

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Order these numbers - largest to smallest:

180 120 160 190

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Order these numbers - smallest to largest:

901 910 190 109

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Order these numbers - largest to smallest:

201 210 120 102

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Order these numbers - smallest to largest:

333 303 344 322

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Order these numbers - largest to smallest:

304 972 456 132
