

Year Two Maths Homework

This homework relates to Maths work covered in class this week. Children are learning to divide amounts which leave a "remainder". Children should be encouraged to practically 'share out' objects into equal sets and then note the remainder (or "what's left over"). Some children may even be able to apply their knowledge of multiplication facts to help mentally calculate remainders.

Dividing with remainders		Use objects or drawings to calculate these division sums. Remember, each sum will have a remainder.	
$7 \div 3 =$  2 in each group with 1 left over.	$16 \div 5 =$ in each group with left over.		
$9 \div 2 =$ remainder .	$8 \div 3 =$ remainder .		
$10 \div 4 =$ remainder .	$13 \div 5 =$ remainder .
