


Bumble Bees

Make some jelly, the brilliant thing is, you can eat and play! Best of both worlds. Make sure you get just as messy!




Shaving foam, great for mark making, smells nice, cleans too. Doesn't have to be letters and words, patterns and shapes work just as well.


Special Homework! Have a go at some of these activities, I've also left the signs and chart on the back for you to use as you go.


