The Nursery will be closed for normal sessions on both days.

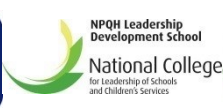
This is always a really exciting visit, not only do we go on the London Eye, but we have a picnic and a short walk along the Thames to look at the sights along the river, the different ways of travelling and take lots of photos.

Please note that all of the children will need to have a parent or family member (18+) present with them during the visit. This is a 'family visit' and will be the first of only two occasions during your child's year in our Nursery when you will be invited to accompany us 'as a family' on a special day out.

We really need your support to make this visit a great success, it is going to be a wonderful experience to share with your child and we are all really excited about going.

The total cost of the visit to school will be approximately £3,588.10 (or, in other words, £46 per child); however, we will use school funds to subsidise some of the cost incurred. Accordingly, we kindly ask you to help us by contributing **£25 per family (child + 1 adult)**, which we ask you to pay via ParentMail.

If you have difficulty in paying, then it is important that you speak to either Donna Bonifacio or Kelly Ager as soon as possible.

Please note that this is a family visit and without your contribution we will not be able to take either you or your child on this visit.
