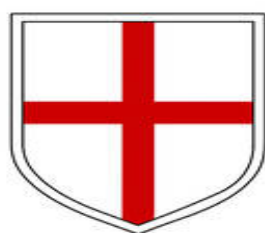

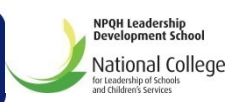

*Friday 20<sup>th</sup> April 2018 at the Joyous regale that is, St. Georges Day Celebrations at Thames View Infants!*



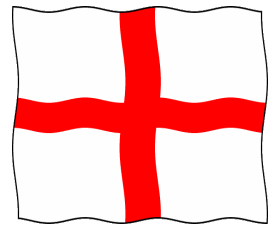
