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Dear Parents/Carers,

## Year 2 Visit to The Ragged School Museum

In History lessons, our Year 2 children have been learning about Schools and to support this work they will be visiting The Ragged School Museum on:

- **Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> December – Squirrels and Foxes**
- **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> December – Snakes and Owls**

The visit will take place during school hours and the children will be back by 3.15pm.

We will be travelling by coach and your child will need to wear their school uniform. A choice of packed lunches for all children will be provided by school on this day and so children will not need to bring anything extra into school with them. Please also note that children will not need any spending money.

### Visit Contribution

The total cost of the visit to school will be approximately £1,970 (or, in other words, £16.42 per child). However, we will use school funds to subsidise some of the costs incurred. Accordingly, we kindly ask you to help us by contributing **£10 per child**, which we ask you to pay via the ParentMail system online or in a shop (the bar code for which has been e-mailed to your ParentMail account).

If you have difficulty in making this contribution, then it is important that you speak to Donna Bonifacio or Kelly Ager as soon as possible. Unfortunately, if we don't receive sufficient payments we may well have to either cancel your child's visit, the whole visit (less our deposit) or future planned for visits through lack of funds – which obviously, we want to avoid.



We're a PAPERLESS School – so you must download & register your ParentMail App to receive e-newsletters, to book after-school clubs & Parents' meetings or to confirm consent for educational visits.

## Consent Form

Please also note that, in order for your child to come on this visit, you need to complete the consent form on ParentMail and return it to us no later than **Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November**. Without your consent we cannot take your child on this visit.

## Parent Helpers

There are a number of places on the coach and we hope some parents will come along to help us. Please remember that on this visit, as with all others in school, parental helpers lead and supervise a small group of children, which does *not* include their own child. The role is essentially to support learning and to engage the children in conversation and a variety of activities that you will be briefed about beforehand. If that sounds like you, then please let us know by completing and submitting the ParentMail form which is now available. **Only parents who have completed this ParentMail form and submitted it to us by Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> November will be eligible to help on this visit.** As soon as we have an idea of numbers, we will get back to you.

As mentioned above, **please make your payment and complete the visit consent form for this visit on ParentMail no later than Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November.** All relevant forms / payment items are now available on ParentMail.
