The 2019 Nursery Families' visit to The Horniman Museum



We are pleased to invite you to join us on our 2019 Nursery family visit to The Horniman Museum. The visit takes place on the dates shown below. It is going to be a wonderful family day out at a beautiful museum in London.

Morning Children will visit on Wednesday 26th June 2019
Afternoon Children will visit on Thursday 27th June 2019
The Nursery will be closed for normal sessions on both days.

There's so much to do at the Horniman Museum and we are sure that the children are going to have a wonderful time. We'll be visiting the Butterfly House, looking at the Aquarium, visiting the 'hands-on' galleries (including a music gallery) as well as enjoying all of the beautiful gardens and nature trails on offer.



Please note that all of the children will need to have a parent or family member (18+) present with them during the visit. This is a 'family visit' and will be the last occasion during your child's year in our Nursery when you will be invited to accompany us 'as a family' on a special day out.



We really need your support to make this visit a great success, it is going to be a wonderful experience to share with your child and we are all really excited about going.

The total cost of the visit to school will be approximately £1,990 (or, in other words, £25.51 per child); however, we will use school funds to subsidise some of the cost incurred. Accordingly, we kindly ask you to help us by contributing **£15 per family (child + 1 adult)**, which we ask you to pay via ParentMail.



We're a PAPERLESS School – so you must download & register your ParentMail App to receive e-newsletters, to book after-school clubs & Parents' meetings or to confirm consent for educational visits.

If you have difficulty in paying, then it is important that you speak to either Donna Bonifacio or Kelly Ager as soon as possible.

Please note that this is a family visit and without your contribution we will not be able to take either you or your child on this visit.
