- 2. Click on the tab 'FORMS' (left hand side).
- 3. Open the form headed CLUBS.
- 4. Select the clubs your child would be interested in attending.
- 5. Press the submit button at the bottom.

The deadline for the submission of forms is Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> January at 8:30am.




Irish Dancing – Back after last terms success this club will keep you on your toes. Run free of charge by the Jordan Academy of Irish Dance and hosted by Daniel.
