## Activities for mental addition to 10

## You will need: <br> Voices

Activity:
Give your child two numbers to add as quickly as they can, e.g. 6+2 (make sure the answer will not exceed 10). Try to encourage your child not to use his/ her fingers.

## You will need: Voices

Activity:
Repeat the above activity in various situations e.g. Pick two numbers from car number plates. Ensure the total of the two numbers does not exceed ten.

## You will need:

Two dice


## Activity:

Roll two dice, how quickly can your child add the two numbers together? If possible, cover the six dots to make a zero instead. This will make sure answers do not go above ten.

## Activities for money

## You will need: <br> A selection of coins



Activity:
Put coins of different values on the table. Name the coins together. While your child closes his/ her eyes, take one coin away. Can he/ she name the missing coin?

## You will need: <br> A selection of coins

Activity:
Take a handful of coins; ask your child to pick out a 10p coin. Replace the coin. Name a different coin. Can your child find it?

## You will need: <br> A selection of coins

Activity:
Discuss the size of coins. Does each coin have a smooth or milled edge? What colour are the coins? While your child has his/ her eyes closed, place a coin in their hand. Can they tell you what coin it is, just by feeling it?

## Activities for money

## You will need: <br> Coins, paper, wax crayons



## Activity:

Help your child to make a variety of rubbings with the coins. Talk about the coins and label the pictures.

## You will need: <br> A 10p coin.

When you go to a sweet shop with your child, give him/ her 10 p to spend. Ask them what they could buy for 10p. Can he/ shetell you how many different ways they could spend the money.
