This is a practical activity: Read these numbers together with your child

We want your child to be able to <u>instantly</u> recall each of these numbers.

Can your child read all these numbers? Point to the numbers one at a time – can your child still read them all? Can your child find these numbers in print throughout the house or when you go shopping?

Children are also learning to have secure 'one-to-one' matching of these numbers.

This is a practical activity:

We want your child to be able to accurately count objects from 1-10.

Find some household objects to count with your child. Count them together with your child. Demonstrate pointing to each object with your finger as you count *("one point for each object/count")*. Watch your child count sets of objects closley. Make sure they are pointing with their finger correctly as they start to count. Is your child able to fingerpoint and count accurately? Repeat with different amounts of objects from 1 to 10.

Extension Activities:

Practise singing counting songs. Point to different numbers – can you child find this number of objects (and count them accurately and reliably?).

We expect your child to completely these tasks together with you. Please see your child's class teacher if you have any further questions on this particular piece of homework or to find out how to provide additional support/extension work.
