

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Year One Maths Homework

This homework relates to Maths work covered in class this week.





Get your child to practise writing these numbers together with you. Get them to name each number as they write it.

We want your child to be able to <u>confidently</u> write these numbers unaided.

Play a number game:

Provide your child with a set of objects (1-10). Get your child to count the objects and then write the amount in a box below. Check to see if they are right, then repeat with a different amount.

Things to think about:

Has your children written the number correctly? Is the number written the 'right way round'? Were they confident at writing the number or did they have to check first?

Extension Activities:

Play making shopping lists together – ask your child to write down amounts of items or prices in pence (1-10p). 'Act out' familiar counting songs ("10 Green Bottles", "10 Current Buns") – ask your child to write down how many bottles/current buns are left etc.

We expect your child to completely these tasks together with you. Please see your child's class teacher if you have any further questions on this particular piece of homework or to find out how to provide additional support/extension work.
