Christmas Fun Days on 9th, 10th and 11th December.



This year we will be holding three socially distanced and Covid secure Christmas Fun Days for the children. In order to ensure that we don't burst any of our bubbles each year group will get their own special Christmas Fun Day on the following dates:

- Wednesday 9th December Reception Christmas Fun Day
- Thursday 10th December Year 1 Christmas Fun Day
- Friday 11th December Year 2 Christmas Fun Day
- Friday 11th December Nursery Christmas Fun Day (Held in Nursery)



Fun Day is a very special day for the children – my favourite day of the School Calender. The hall will be transformed into a mini **Christmas Bazaar**, recreating the type of traditional Infant school Christmas celebrations that we as parents grew up with when we were young.



WE NEED

There will be various festive stalls, run by School Staff and Children will have the opportunity to make traditional Christmas decorations that they will then be able to take home with them.



There will also be a 'bring and buy stall' – where children will be able to 'buy back' toy and book donations. (So now is the time for you to start searching your toy cupboards for any suitable unwanted toy donations). All children in attendance will have the opportunity to have their photograph taken with Father Christmas, which will be available for you to purchase at a later date for £2.00.

In the afternoon the children will have their fun filled Christmas class parties complete with party food and festive themed party games.

Children really enjoy the day and they also gain a valuable insight into the principles of shopping and budgeting - like arown-ups.





Christmas Jumper Day on Friday 11th December

This year we are also going to be supporting 'Save the Children' and participating in 'Christmas Jumper Day'. More information will follow closer to the time but on Friday 11th December all children are invited to wear their Christmas Jumpers to school in return for a donation of £1 which we will pass on to this important charity. Please note that on this day, children who wish to participate should wear their normal uniform but with their Christmas Jumper on top.

This year we're doing a very different kind of socially distanced Christmas Concert for our parents to enjoy!
