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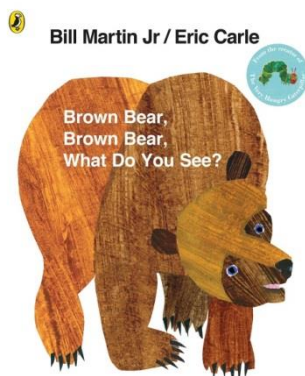
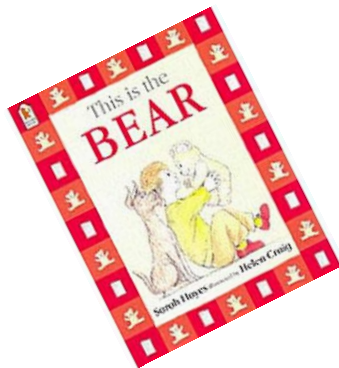

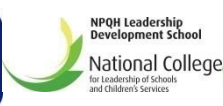
Nursery learning next week!

Remember communication is so important. If you're worried, unsure about anything or would just like to know how your child is learning, feel free to pop in and see us! It's good to talk.

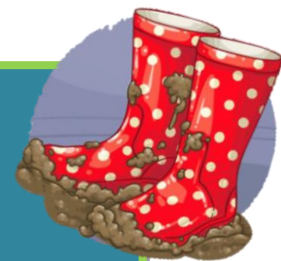

Recipe for biscuits

2 cups of plain flour

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup of caster sugar

$\frac{1}{2}$ butter

2tbsp vanilla extract (optional)

Mix all the ingredients together

Roll the dough

Use cutters and place in the baking tray

Cooking time is between 15-20 minutes
