Learning summary for next week:

- Continuing to learn about our new topic:
 - Learning names of different types of building
 - o Ordering events; getting dressed, cooking etc. using first, then, next, finally.
 - Matching rhyming words
- Letters and Sounds (phonics)
 - New sounds: h, b, f, ff, l
 - o Tricky words: the, to, I go, no
 - Practising blending (for reading), and sounding out/segmenting for writing. Use the homework sheet in your packs, and words used in the Letters and Sounds lessons.
- Maths Numbers as labels for counting:
 - Ordering numbers to 20
 - Saying what comes before and after a number
 - o Recognising a number and finding it on the number line
