Please watch all the Twitter video lessons if you are learning from home. If you can't watch them live, you can catch up with them later in the day. Here is a brief summary of the topics we will be covering in the coming weeks learning:

Learning summary for next week:

- Continuing to learn about homes and buildings during topic teach:
 - Learning about how we send letters and what happens at the Post Office
 - Retelling the story of the Three Little Pigs
 - Playing memory games and using language to explain what has happened
 - Sorting objects by initial sounds
 - Counting and labelling houses and windows
 - Rhythmical drawing to support our writing skills
- Letters and Sounds (phonics)
 - New sounds: *y, z, zz* and *qu*
 - New tricky words: *we, me, be, and, said*
 - Practising blending (for reading), and sounding out/segmenting (for writing). Use the homework sheet in your packs, and words used in the Letters and Sounds lessons.
- Maths – Numbers up to 20
 - Recapping numbers to 20. Recognising, counting, before and after
 - Counting out the correct number objects carefully and accurately
 - Writing numbers up to 20 in order
 - Beginning to add numbers together and write a number sentence
- Writing – Guided writing session (on Wednesday)
 - Writing a simple sentence about a walk around the local area
 - Using what we know:
 - ✓ Tricky words we have learnt
 - ✓ Segmenting (identifying the sounds we can hear in a word)
 - ✓ Saying our sentence to help us remember what comes next

I hope you find this information useful, and we are all looking forward to seeing what you have done when you return to school.
