This week we will see you again every day on twitter. We will be retelling the story Jim and the Beanstalk in writing this week.

For Maths we will be subtracting 11 and 12 and multiples of 10 from a 2 digit number, we will be using repeated addition to solve lots of sums and then answering word problems too.

In Science continuing our topic of animals we will be learning about what keeps us healthy looking at food and exercise.

As well in the afternoons, we will continue to learn about the Great Fire of London in History and in Geography we will be exploring the different areas that you will find on an island. In DT and Art we will be looking at different buildings writing about them and drawing them.
