Activities for Friday 5th March:

1. Instead of topic teach at 9am:
 - ✓ Use the *Goldilocks and The Three Bears* story board from your weekly pack to help you retell the story:
 - 1.Can you remember what happened in the story (first, then, next, finally)
 - 2.Can you remember what the characters said?
 - 3.Are you able to do different voices for the different characters?
 - 4.What happened at the end of the story?
2. Instead of Letters and Sounds at 9:50am:
 - ✓ Practice all 4 new sounds we have done this week (oo, ao, ai, ee)
 - ✓ Revise the tricky words introduced during the week, plus any others taught recently. Use your homework sheet from this week, and those from previous weeks to help.
 - ✓ Use the letters used for phoneme frame to write the following words:
1.boat, goat, food, boot
3. Instead of Maths at 12:50pm:
 - ✓ Following on from our work on shapes this week, today try adding the number of sides of two shapes together. Use the 2D shapes you have been using from your packs all week. Use the blank number sentence sheets in your packs to record.
 1. Choose two shapes from your selection of 2D shapes
 2. Count the sides on the first shape and write the number down in the first box
 3. The count the sides of the second shape and write that down in the next box
 4. Then count all the sides of both shapes together. And write the answer:
