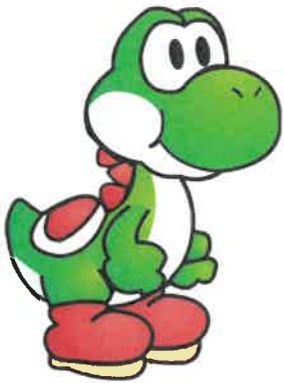
LEARNING IN YEAR1 @home
