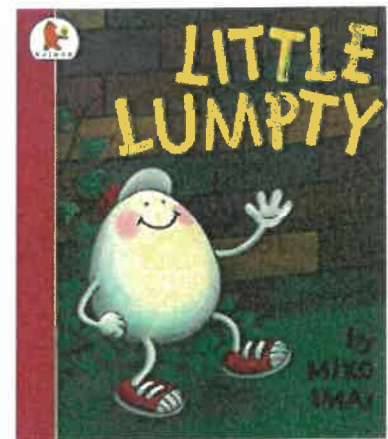
Dear Parents/Carers;



This week we will be continuing to write about 'Little Lumpty' but it will be our own version and we will be changing the wall.

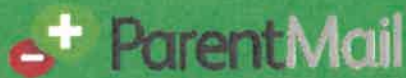
Children have settled back into school really well. Don't forget homework including yellow books comes home on a Monday and is brought back to school on a Friday. Please keep writing in your child's reading records too.
