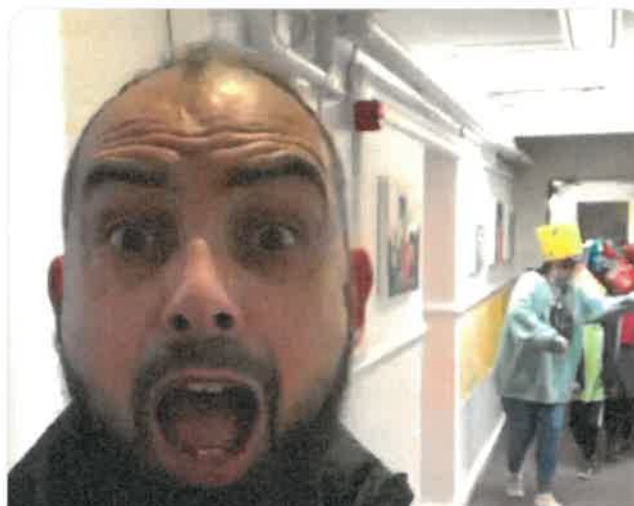

### Keeping Everyone Safe
