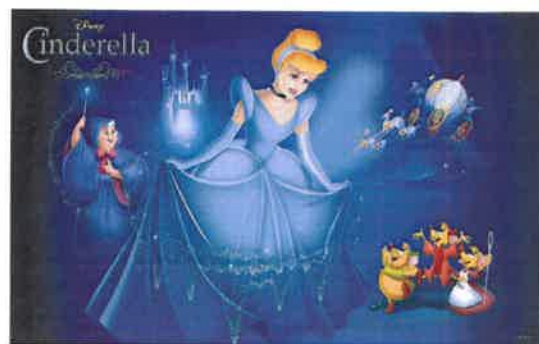

Dear Parents/Carers;

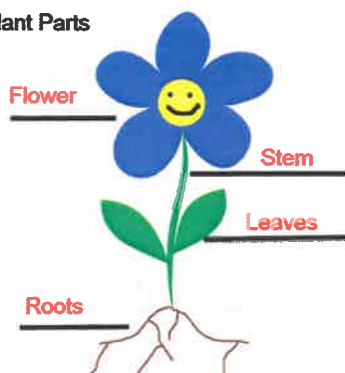
This week we will be reading Cinderella and writing our own invitation to her wedding.
