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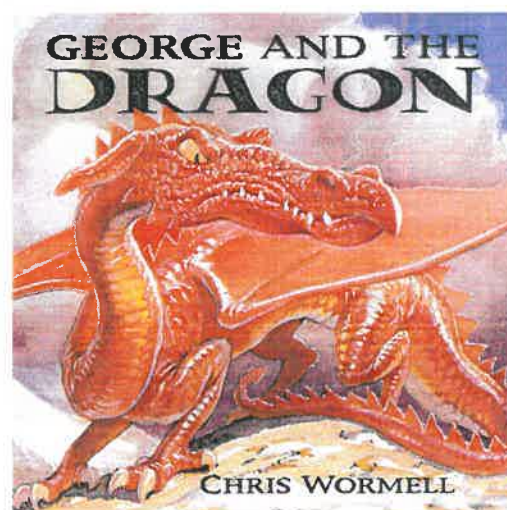

Dear Parents/Carers;

- This week we will be writing about the Dragon in George and the dragon. We will be describing his appearance and personality.
- In Maths we will be writing a multiplication sum as an addition sum and then solving 2-step word problems.

Please help us by reading with your child every night. We are focussing on *fluency* in children's reading in order to help them progress even further. Once a child becomes fluent in reading it allows them more time to understand what they are reading and they can access higher level books.

Don't forget this term the weather will start to get brighter and warmer so make sure children are coming to school in a t-shirt and not too many layers. Encourage them to take ownership of how they feel and how they can help themselves if they get too hot.
