## 2021 Nursery Sports Day and Family Picnic @TVI

We are delighted to confirm that we are going to be hosting a special Sports Day for our Nursery children this year and you are invited to attend!

In order to keep everybody safe, and still comply with the Covid guidelines and regulations, we are having a separate Sports Day for every year group and the dates and times for Nursery are given below:

- Morning Nursery – 9:30am on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July
- Afternoon Nursery – 1:15pm on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July



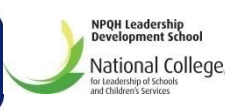
*(Please note that prior to entry parents will have their ParentMail forms checked, temperatures taken, and Lateral Flow tests checked before being signed in).*

In order that we are allowed to run this event, we have been advised that there are some rules that we must ask you to adhere to. I have listed these below and we will need you to complete the online ParentMail form in order to confirm your agreement to them.

Unfortunately, following these rules is compulsory in order to be able to come into our school. However, I am sure that you will agree, these rules are a small price to pay for the opportunity to see your child compete in his/her Sports Day and help us start to get school 'back to normal'.

- We will need you to complete a ParentMail form in advance of you attending Sports Day. We need you to do this because:

1. We need your confirmation that you will agree to the rules stipulated below.



We're a PAPERLESS School – so you must download & register your ParentMail App to receive e-newsletters, to book after-school clubs & Parents' meetings or to confirm consent for educational visits.

2. We need to keep track of the numbers of people who are going to be on-site in order to ensure that everyone is socially distanced.

3. We need this information for track and trace purposes.

- We will need any guests attending Sports Day to carry out a Lateral Flow Covid test on the morning of their child's Sports Day. Please have a copy of your negative test confirmation/s ready to show us on your phone.
- We will need you to scan into our premises using the NHS app before you come into the playground.
- We will need you to wear your mask for the duration of the morning, (obviously taking it off for a while for the picnic while you eat).
- We need you to agree to not gather in groups of more than 6 people.
- We can only allow a maximum of two guests to attend per pupil.
- Finally, on the day we will also take your temperature before you come onsite and ask you to use some antibacterial gel on your hands.

There will be medals for the winners and we expect our Nursery Sports Day events to be a lovely opportunity where you can come into school once again and see just how good your children are at competing in teams and supporting one another.

Sports Day will be followed by a picnic outside in our beautiful school field. School will provide all of the children with refreshments and you are invited to bring in a picnic that you can share with your child as well.

We are certain that all of our year group Sports Days are going to be a huge success and we are optimistic that they will pave the way for School returning back to normal, enabling us to welcome our families back onto site once again.

Obviously, we have to remind you that all of the above is weather permitting...if we have to make any changes to our plans we'll let you know as soon as possible.
