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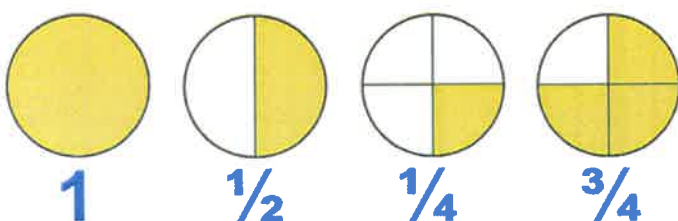

Dear Parents/Carers;

- This week we will be writing a character description about 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'. We will be writing about his appearance and personality.
- In Maths we will be working out fractions of amounts and then moving on to division with remainders.
