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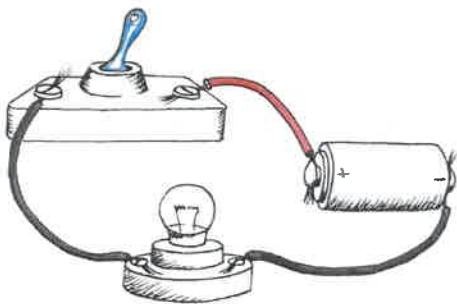
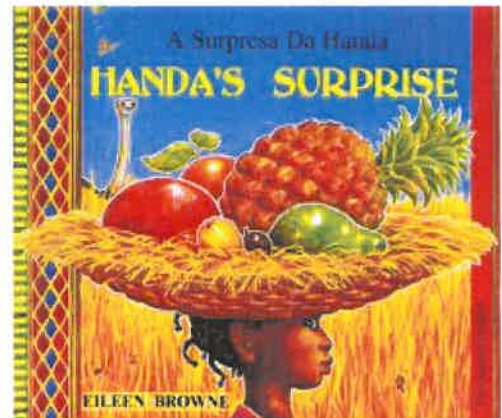

## Year 2

Dear Parents/Carers;

- This week we will be retelling the story of Handa's Surprise. We will be using sentence openers and exploring story language.
- In Maths we will be collecting data and presenting it on a table. We will then be telling time to the nearest 5 minutes.
- In Science we will be exploring an electric circuit and what the different components are.



In the afternoons:

- PE – In Games we are learning how to serve a ball for a friend to hit.
- Geography – We will be exploring what you would need to travel to Albania.
- History – We will be writing a letter to the doctors in Scutari explaining all the problems

Don't forget this term the weather will start to get brighter and warmer so make sure children are coming to school in a t-shirt and not too many layers. Encourage them to take ownership of how they feel and how they can help themselves if they get too hot.

Please help us by reading with your child every night. We are focussing on *fluency* in children's reading in order to help them progress even further. Once a child becomes fluent in reading it allows them more time to understand what they are reading and they can access higher level books.

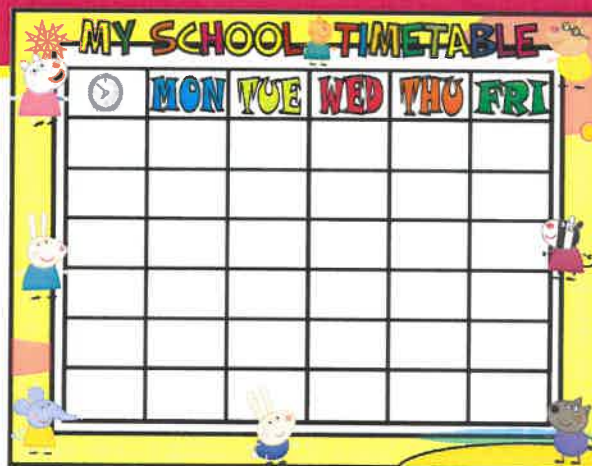
