Some News About Coming Back to School for Bumblebees

School re-opens on Monday 1st November for all of our children except for those in Bumblebees. Our Bumblebees staff are having a special staff training day on this day and so we look forward to welcoming our Bumblebees children back on Tuesday 2nd November.

Covid Tests Before Your Child Returns

Please <u>click here</u> for a link to a letter that Public Health England have asked us to circulate to all of our parents regarding the rise in Coronavirus cases in schools. As you can see, their advice is that you get your child tested before they come back to school after the break.

We are keen to avoid any school closures in this coming half term, especially with so many lovely events planned for the remainder of the year and, in light of the above, we are kindly requesting that <u>all</u> children have a Covid test before they return to school on 1st November.

In line with the advice from Public Health England, we therefore ask:

- All Nursery and Reception children to have a PCR Covid test before they return to school
- All Year 1 and Year 2 children to have a Lateral Flow Covid test before they return to school.

Because this is so important, please can we ask that you email the school office the NHS results of your child's test ahead of their return to school on 1st November. Please put your child's name and class in the subject field of your email. The office email address is Office@thamesviewinfants.org.

Monday 1st November – Hallowe'en

The idea is that you make a pumpkin at home with your child over half term and bring it in on Monday 1st November (with your child's name on it!) We'll display all the lanterns all around our School for the week and we'll award prizes for the best.

Thursday 4th November – Diwali

Our Hindu and Sikh families will be celebrating Diwali when we come back from the break. As a school, we value the rich diversity of our Community and as part of our curriculum we recognise a range of celebrations shared within our families. As you know, we celebrated Harvest just a few weeks ago and Eid earlier this year. In celebration of Diwali, we are holding a special Diwali assembly for our children on Thursday 4th November with a delicious Diwali themed meal for school lunch. Following on from this, on Wednesday 17th November, all of our KS1 children will take part in special Diwali Dance workshops facilitated by 'West End in Schools'.

Thursday 18th November – Reading Meetings for Reception Parents

For our Reception Parents, there's a special Reading meeting at school on Thursday 18th November, starting at 3:30pm (and repeated again at 5pm on ZOOM

for parents who can't make the earlier slot). We're going to be starting our phonics lessons with the children over the next few weeks and this meeting will let you know how we teach phonics / reading here at TVI and what you can do at home to help. Please note that this meeting is for Reception parents

only. A crèche facility will be available at the 3:30pm meeting if

needed.

Friday 5th November – Guy Fawkes Night

To celebrate Guy Fawkes Night at school we'll be holding a special Assembly on Friday 5th November all about the story of Guy Fawkes and his famous Gunpowder Plot. We'll also be having a special Bonfire Night themed lunch at

school. During this week our Year 2 classes will also have interactive workshops with some of our friendly local firemen who will be talking to the children all about fire safety.

Friday 19th November – Children in Need Day

This year we'll be celebrating Children in Need at school on Friday 19th November. Please read our special Children in Need letter which will tell you all about what we're going to be doing at school in order to help Pudsey raise money for Children in Need.

Please note that this will be a non-uniform day and the theme will be "Two

Pounds for Pudsey" - with children making a £2 donation each towards BBC Children in Need.

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












Wednesday 3rd, Thursday 4th and Friday 5th November – Nursery Parent/Teacher Meetinas

Enter school on 9th November with your child. Our specially extended parent-participation lesson will take place from 9:10 – 9:40am and will be followed by a 15 minute Question and Answer de-brief by each Class Teacher afterwards.
