Dear Parents/Carers;

Every week on a Friday we will send out a letter telling you what's ahead for your child in Bumble Bees. I wanted to make sure that you know what's going on in Bumble Bees as children may not tell you what they've learnt, what activities they've been doing or even who they played with.

Make sure you continue to check the PARENTMAIL APP to keep up to date.

Children in Bumble Bees are taught an adapted curriculum based on what the rest of their Year Group are doing. In Bumble Bees we modify the work for the needs of your children, so sometimes we will do different activities. Bumble Bee's children from Year 1 and 2 will take part in a short whole-class teaching sessions, followed by a wide range of carefully planned activities to consolidate their learning in class and outdoors. Children from Reception will soon be directed to join in with small group activities led by an adult. Where appropriate, children are supported one-to-one with an adult to complete their activities.

We encourage children to explore the outside area whatever the weather. Please make sure they have welly boots and a suitable coat for all weather conditions.

Please remember:

- ✓ Children need slippers and their names written in everything
- ✓ No hooped earrings (we recommend no studs either)
- ✓ Yellow school book bags everyday

- School begins at 8:55am
- School ends at 3:15pm
- Children will now come straight to Bumble Bees and be collected from there at the end of the day.
- Children will receive a healthy school lunch every day
- They will bring home a new book to read everyday
- Please provide Wellie boots and rain coats for rainy days,
