

rules for attending our christmas concerts

Over the course of the next week your child will bring home your ticket for the concert in their book bag. We will only be issuing one ticket per child.



·You must have a ticket – you will not be allowed in without your ticket. We will be taking the tickets off of you as you come in.

·Please do not lose your ticket – we cannot issue replacement tickets.

You will only be allowed to attend on the day allocated to your child's class, which will be printed on the ticket. You cannot attend on any other day.

·You will need to wear a face mask at all times and any under 5s must be with you at all times.

·You will need to have conducted a lateral flow test on the morning of your child's concert.

If you are ill in any way at all, you must not come into school.

Due to copyright reasons, unfortunately, we will not be able to stream or video the concert for you in your absence.
