New Topic – Homes and Buildings

- Letters and Sounds (phonics)
 - o Recap sounds: g, o, c, k
 - o Tricky words: and, on, not, into
 - o Practising blending (for reading), and sounding out/segmenting for writing. Use the homework sheet in your packs, and words used in the Letters and Sounds lessons.
- Maths Numbers as labels for counting:
 - Ordering numbers to 20
 - Saying what comes before and after a number
 - Recognising a number and finding it on the number line
