It's been a lovely week in Bumble Bees 😊 Here is everything you need to know for next week!

Reception and Year 1 children.

Topic Teach – We will look at how bears use their senses.

Letter and sounds - The sounds we are learning this week are; **ar, or, igh,** and **ur.**

Guided write – This week children will write a sentence from the story Time to sleep Alfie Bear.

Maths – Children will begin to look at and compare heavy and light objects.

Fine Motor – Children will explore in various activities at the workstation to help develop their fine motor skills.

Writing – Children will read and write about Little Lumpty.

RSWS – We will look at phase 5 sounds – oy, ir, ue like oo, ue like you and 'aw'

Maths – We will look at division and time.

Red Nose Day – 18th March 2022

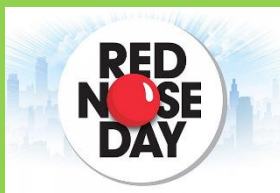
Next Friday is Red Nose Day! We are inviting in our Parents and Carers for a Super Hero Craft Day.
