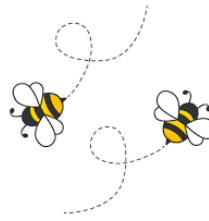
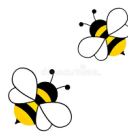

Bumble Bees Family Visit to Shoeburyness

Our Bumble Bees children have been learning about Seasides and to support this work, they will be visiting Shoeburyness on **Wednesday 13th July**.

This is a family visit and we are looking forward to you joining us for the day. We will provide a packed lunch for the children to take with them on the day. For yourself, you will need to bring your own packed lunch and it would be lovely if you could bring along some extra snacks to share with your child as well.



At most, the children will only be padding their toes in the water. However, on the day your child will still need:

- A full set of clothes to change into (including underwear and shoes)
- A towel
- Pull-ups / nappies / wipes (if these are needed for your child)
- A sunhat and sun cream if it is a sunny day
- A raincoat if it is a rainy day



The expectation is that an adult from each family will accompany their child on this special day out.

The visit will take place during school hours, we will be travelling by coach and the children will be back by 3.15pm.

Children will not need any spending money on the day.

Contribution Payment for the Visit

The total cost of the visit to school will be approximately £350 (or, in other words, £21.87 per child). Accordingly, we kindly ask you to help us by contributing **£12 per family**, which we ask you to pay via ParentMail.

If you have difficulty in paying, then it is important that you speak to either Donna Bonifacio or Kelly Ager as soon as possible. Unfortunately, if we don't receive sufficient contributions we may well have to either cancel the whole visit (less our deposit) or future planned for visits through lack of funds – which obviously, we want to avoid.
