Science – This week we will continue to learn about plants.

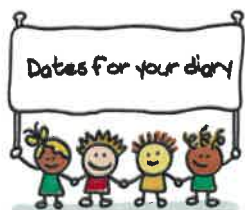
History – We will look at Florence Nightingale.
