Learning summary:

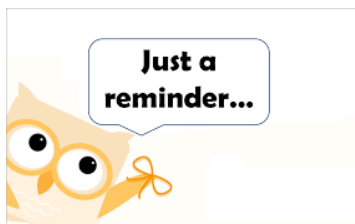
