

Please note that there will be strictly no admission to the Open Day after 9am, so if you'd like to attend, please make sure that you are on time!

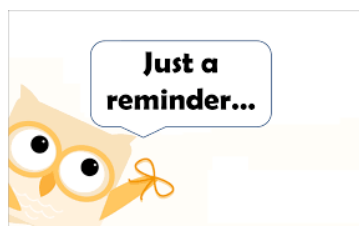
2022 Father's Day Celebrations @TVI
