## Thames View Infants Music Scheme of Work

- Identify metre by recognising its pattern
- Divide the number 12 into 2s, 3s and 4s
- Explore different ways to emphasise beats to form a group
- Explore sounds on instruments and finding different ways to vary their sound

Film the environment to the north, south, east and west of the school

Create a soundscape of your school surroundings to add to 'The compass song'

Sing a song about animals and tap knees on the animal sounds

Perform an animal song, marking beats with voices and bodies

Count out beats in groups of twos, threes and fours

Perform a number pattern using taps and claps

Match sounds to beat patterns

Listen to different ways of marking a strong beat

Practise counting in two, three and four beat groups

Perform two, three and four beat groups with hissing sounds
