Each week, the class with the best attendance in each year group will be given Everyday Ray to look after.

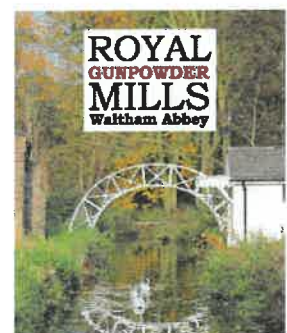
