What a busy week it's been in Bumble Bees this week 😊 Here is what's coming up next week!

### Reception

**Topic Teach** – Children will recap the names of vehicles, children will use their phonics to sound out CVC words.

**Letter and sounds** – Children will continue to learn Phase 2 sounds 'g' and phase 3 sounds 'oi and ow'

**Guided write** – This week children will write words to match pictures.

**Maths** – Children will recap the names of coins and give amounts to buy an item.

**Fine Motor** – Children will explore in various activities at the workstation to help develop their fine motor skills.



### Year 1 and 2

**Writing** – Children will continue to write about the Gruffalo.

**RSWS** – We will learn out phase 5 sounds this week – ea, ue, oy and ir

**Science** – This week we will look at the world around us.

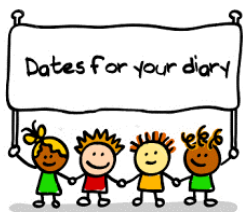
**History** – We will continue to look at seaside's and describe them.
