## Black History Month and Multicultural Day @TVI

I am delighted to let you know that we will be celebrating Black History Month throughout October and then at the end of the month we'll be having our very own Multicultural Day when we'll be celebrating *all* of our different cultures. I wanted to let you know about some of the exciting activities that we have coming up this month in celebration of the diversity of culture we have here at TVI.

A Carnival of Stories for Reception...

Reception children will be taking part in a special Early Years story hunt when the Freshwater Theatre Company come into school on the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> October. The theme will be 'A Carnival of



Stories' and the story hunt is designed to support Black History Month. The story hunt will start in England in *Amazing Grace*, then onto Kenya in *Handa's Surprise* and finally to the Caribbean in *Island Counting*, with the children taking part in interactive activities based around these stories.

Stories from Africa for Years 1 and 2...

Then, on 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> October, the Freshwater Theatre Company will be in again for Years 1 and 2. This time the theme will be 'Stories from Africa'.

Children in Years 1 and 2 will see the tales of *How Anansi Became King of All Stories* and *How the Zebra Got His Stripes* dramatically unfold as the children will come together to create animated scenes inspired by African storytelling.























The children will explore the morals of these stories, whilst learning about the oral tradition, Ashanti folk tales and creation stories. Encounter charaters such as Mmoboro the Hornet; Onini the Python; and Osebo the Leopard.
