### Daisy Room

**Communication** – Children will work with an adult to say what they can see. Children will follow actions.

**Maths** – Children will be exploring shapes this week.

**Fine Motor** – Children will explore in various activities at the workstation to help develop their fine motor skills.

**Phonics** – Children will start phonics learning sounds 's' and 'a'.



### Poppy Room

**Writing** – Children will read and write about Farmer Duck.

**RSWS** – We will learn the sounds 'ur', 'ow', 'oi', 'ear'.
