What work is taking place in Writing, Reading and Maths at TVI?*

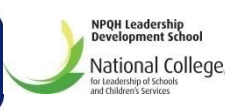


I am excited to let you know that on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> February, between 8:45am-11am, we will be holding an Open Day/Morning for all of our current Parents and Carers.

We really want to show you, if possible, what happens in School on an “everyday” day to day basis.

The provision here at Thames View Infants is Outstanding and we would like to share with you what that looks and “feels like” after you drop your child off at our Academy each day.

Our Open Day is different to our family “Learning Together” sessions. It’s more of a ‘fly on the wall’ type experience where you can come in and observe a variety of lessons across school – from Nursery all the way up to Year 2 – and not just within your child’s class. The day will be facilitated by Adam and myself and other key leaders who will help provide you with a narrative as to what is going on and explain the learning taking place. We will help usher you around school and signpost you to different lessons/year groups and answer questions about our provision. It will be a great opportunity for you to see exactly what learning is like throughout our School.



We're a PAPERLESS School – so you must download & register your **ParentMail App** to receive e-newsletters, to book after-school clubs & Parents' meetings or to confirm consent for educational visits.

On the day, you will come into the school hall at 8:45am, having dropped off your child.

### Time-Table For The Morning

#### **9am – Presentation by Paul – Internet Safety – How We Keep Our Children Safe Online**

At 9am there will be a short presentation by myself on Internet Safety focusing on how you can help keep your child safe online and how we keep the children safe online whilst in School.

#### **9:15am – 10:15am Parents/Carers Look Around School**

You will be free to walk around school for an hour from 9:30am, observing lessons and seeing how the children use the internet to aid their Learning in School. This will be followed by a 'Question and Answer' session in small groups at 10:30am.

**Please note that there will be strictly no admission to the Open Day after 8:45am, so if you'd like to attend, please make sure that you are on time!**

As an NLE (National Leader of Education) we sometimes host days like this to other schools in order to share our Outstanding expertise with them. We thought that it would be nice to give you the privilege of encountering this experience for yourselves so that you might also see learn a bit more about how our school works and what makes it just so special. **Please note however, this will be more of a "whisper and watch"/"silent and see"-style session, rather than our more familiar "Learning Together" sessions.**

Sadly, due to space restrictions, we are limited to two family members per family only. Mobile phones will not be allowed (as we want the children to not be distracted and for you to see, as much as possible, what happens "normally"). Because of the large number of people expected, buggies will also not be allowed in School.
