Science – Children will tell us what they know about animals.

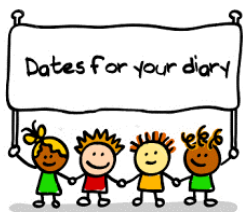
History – Children will continue their topic about the Great Fire of London

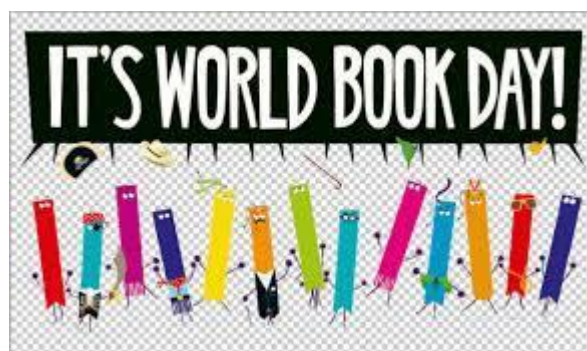
Parent mail – Please keep up to date with any messages on parent mail. Any concerns, please come and see us in Bumble Bees.
