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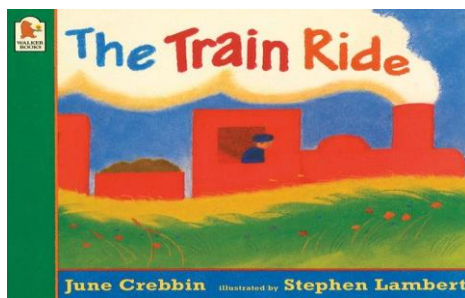

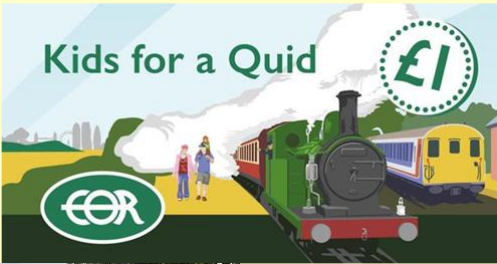


Unfortunately, Nursery can't visit all together. Travelling by coach adds considerable cost to all Educational visits.

However, visiting the Epping and Ongar Railway is much more affordable to go on your own. The Railway is open on weekends, and many other holiday dates. It's well worth a visit if your child (or grown-ups!) enjoy trains, buses and days out.
