## Family Learning Together

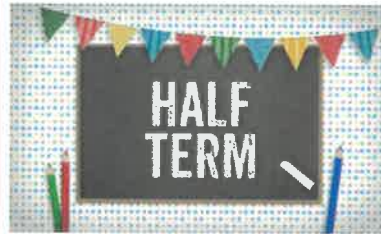
This week in Maths, we have been learning about time. Play the classic game of 'What's the Time Mr Wolf?'. You can play this game in your local park or even in your garden.
