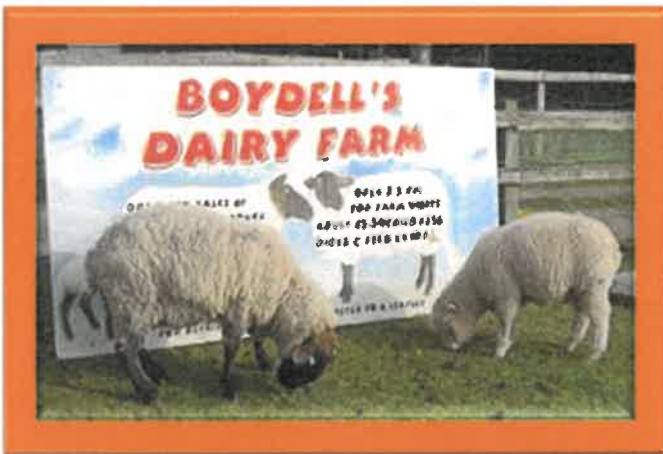
Reception Learning Week!

Snakes and Foxes – Wednesday 15th May

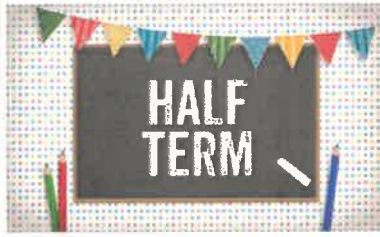
Squirrels and Owls – Thursday 16th May
