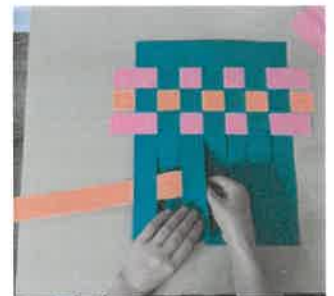
To help children understand how food gets from the farm to our shops and home they will be visiting Barleylands Farm in Billericay. The dates for the visits are:
