

The idea is that you find an old box (shoe box/cereal box etc) and you and your child decide on a scene that you'd like to create. You then work on this at home with your child between now and


















World Book Day and your child will be given the opportunity to use their box to retell the story to their classmates. For inspiration, please see the following gallery for examples of stories in boxes:
