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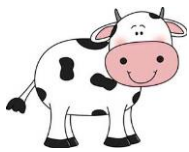

In order to support learning this term, the children in Reception will be going to Boydell's Dairy Farm in Braintree on the following dates:

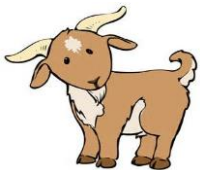


Tuesday 29th April – Tigers and Gorillas

The visit will take place during school hours and the children will be back by 3.15pm.

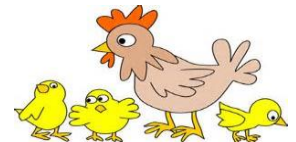
As you know, we are learning all about farms in Reception this term. We will be reading books to find out information, talking about pictures and building our own farms. During our visit, in addition to looking around the farm and meeting all of the animals, each class will watch a milking demonstration and get to see how a real working farm operates. We are all looking forward to an exciting day.



We will be travelling by coach. Your child will need to wear sensible clothing and appropriate footwear. Please note that children will not need to bring a packed lunch - [Packed lunches will be provided for all children](#) and water will be available too. Children will not need any spending money on the day.
